

VANCOUVER CITY CENTER VISION (VCCV) PROJECT

In 1998 the City of Vancouver adopted the Esther Short Redevelopment Plan which provided guidance for \$250 million of new development in the 30 blocks surrounding Esther Short Park. The success of that initial plan called for its expansion to 130 blocks to again provide a foundation with some truly visionary elements and an invitation for the next wave of development. Identity Clark County partnered with the Port of Vancouver and the City of Vancouver to make this project possible.

Highlights of the 20-year development/redevelopment plan include the conversion of Main St. and Broadway back to 2-way traffic flow, reclaiming the waterfront for public use and residential/commercial development, further residential development in the core area, rehabbing 7th St. and “old” downtown Vancouver.
